HIGHFIELD PARK - Matches

Each week the Secretary will draw up a schedule for Saturday and Sunday use. There is a map of the site on the club website but for convenience purpose pitches 1 – 2 - 3 are all on the main front field; pitches 4 -- 5 – 6 – 7 are on the cricket (back) field; pitches 8 – 9 – 10 – 11 are on the new(side) field.

NETS ETC.

The nets for pitches 1 – 2 – 3 are kept in the Charters Health Club store. They should have been put outside the back door to the storeroom and should be put back there after use. If they are not there you will need to ask for them at reception.

For all the other pitches the nets etc. are kept in boxes in the pavilion storeroom. Please ensure that after use they are returned in the boxes to the shelves for nets rather than just dumped anywhere for someone else to clear up. The same applies to Respect Barriers and corner flags.

OPENING AND LOCKING UP

On Saturdays this will normally be arranged. For Sundays a manager will be nominated on the schedule for each task. Keys have to be collected and returned to Reception at Charters Health Club If locking up **please check all lights are off** in changing rooms/toilets and ensure all doors are locked with the Allen key and the normal key.

You will also need to ensure the **gate to the road is locked**. If there is a game going on the front field and cars are parked inside the gate pass the keys to the manager of the side playing who will then be responsible for locking the gate and returning the keys to Charters.

PARKING

On Saturday parking is very tight. Please encourage your opposition to park in the Charters car park and walk through, particularly if playing on the front or side field. If playing on the back field, please ensure you let them know there is a car park there.
